

# Touring Ride in Rural Indiana® June 20-26, 2010

## TRIRI® WEEK PREVIEW

TRIRI® 2010 travels over hard-surfaced roads to take in the scenic and historic sites of south central Indiana, using back roads to travel to three properties: Newton-Stewart SRA, Lincoln State Park, and Harmonie State Park. Terrain ranges from rolling to hilly.

•**Sunday (50 miles) and Monday (layover day; 0, 23, 41 or 60 miles): Brown County State Park.** Enjoy the journey to Indiana's largest state park, home to beautiful hiking and mountain bike trails, and a former host of the 1987 Pan Am Games cycling road race. On the layover day, cycle to the Cordry-Sweetwater Lakes area, or visit the former artist colony of Nashville.

•**Tuesday (62 miles) and Wednesday (layover day; 0, 24, 50 or 100 miles): Spring Mill State Park.** Travel through a section of Indiana known for its round barns on the way to Spring Mill State Park, famous for its pioneer village and working grist mill. On the layover day, choose from two new loop rides: a medium loop ride to the restored Beck's Mill, or a long loop ride with lunch at a winery.

•**Thursday (80 miles) and Friday (layover day; 0, 13, 24, or 70 miles): Clifty Falls State Park.** Clifty Falls is known for its waterfalls, rugged hiking trails, and its proximity to historic Madison on the Ohio River. On the layover day, explore Madison's 19th century architecture or ride your bicycle to Hanover and Bethlehem.

•**Saturday (40 miles): Clifty Falls State Park to Hardy Lake.** Savor your final trip through rural Indiana, with its farms and small towns, on your way back to Hardy Lake. Stop and enjoy the Stream Cliff Tea Room as you bid farewell to Indiana's quiet rural beauty.

## TRIRI® ACCOMMODATIONS

Indiana State Parks entry fees and TRIRI® group camping fees are covered by your ride entry. TRIRI® group campsites are located near shower facilities. **All vehicles parked overnight at the TRIRI® campsites must display the special permit for registered non-riders.**

## TRIRI® MEALS

Breakfasts (6) and dinners (6) are included and furnished at each overnight site. Menus are carefully planned for sound nutrition and include options for vegetarian and diabetic participants. Meals are served at the TRIRI® campsite on picnic tables under large awnings. Route maps indicate where food may be purchased each day. Some days you may need to buy and carry food with you on the more isolated parts of the route.

## TRIRI® SERVICES

•**Circle City Bicycles** mechanic Bill Hannah will accompany TRIRI® with a rolling shop to make bicycle repairs both on the road and in the campgrounds (charging for parts and labor). Be prepared to take care of routine bicycle repairs, such as flat tires, yourself. If you're flying to the start of the ride and need to have your bicycle assembled, contact Bill at 1-800-793-7801 to discuss the details and fees for this service.

•Two **SAG vehicles** will follow the group for emergency needs. We recommend that each rider be covered by a medical insurance policy and carry identification at all times in case of emergency.

•**Padre's Cycle Inn** will join us in 2010 to offer comfort camping services: tent, chair, towel and washcloth rental, and snacks. Contact him at (573) 721-4400 or visit <http://www.padrecycleinn.com> for more information.

•Lodging at the Indiana State Park inns will be available during the week at the regular summer room rate. A block of rooms has been reserved for TRIRI® participants; use the code to reserve a room.

## PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

Parking for the week has been arranged at Hardy Lake SRA. The \$7 parking permit is required for this service. To receive it in your registration packet, check the box indicating that you need parking for the week and supply your vehicle information. We are providing a place for you to leave your vehicle for the week, but neither TRIRI®, Hardy Lake SRA, nor the Indiana DNR is responsible for the safety of your vehicle, as stated in the TRIRI® waiver.

## REGISTRATION, RATES & CANCELLATION

•**Registration closes June 1.** Early bird registration ends May 12; after that date, registration increases by \$25/person. You will receive a confirmation postcard within two weeks after you register; contact us if you do not receive one. The Participant Information Newsletter is available for download at your convenience at [www.triri.org](http://www.triri.org). Registration packets, with your maps for the entire week, will be available for pick-up just prior to the ride.

•**Week-long Cycling or Driving Participants:** Your registration fee includes a short-sleeve t-shirt, 12 meals, evening entertainment, park entry and camping fees, showers, baggage transport, SAG support, massage therapy and bicycle mechanic availability, maps, marked routes, and a week-in-review DVD. Drivers receive a set of driving route maps and a pass that covers park gate fees and allows parking at the TRIRI® group campsite.

•**Daily Participants:** Those unable to attend the entire week are welcome to register as Daily Participants. Your registration fee covers two consecutive meals, camping, and maps for the days you ride, as well as the TRIRI® DVD. The TRIRI® t-shirt is not included, but is available for purchase.

•Indiana child safety laws requiring restraint seats make it illegal for our support vehicles to transport children 7 and under; Therefore, all **children transported by bicycle** must be at least 8 years old. Younger children are welcome if a member of their party is registered as a Driving Participant and acts as their personal SAG each day. *In all cases, minors (anyone under the age of 18 years) must be accompanied by a supervising, registered adult, and that adult must be identified on the minor's registration form.*

•**All cancellations must be in writing.** Cancellations postmarked or time/date stamped by May 12, 2010 will be refunded minus \$50/person. *No refunds will be given after May 12, but you may provide a substitute to ride in your place.* **Trip cancellation insurance** is available from McKay Insurance at (800) 942-0283.

PLEASE READ AND SIGN THE RELEASE TO BE OFFICIALLY REGISTERED: I, the undersigned, freely acknowledge and realize the dangers of participating in Touring Ride In Rural Indiana® (TRIRI®) and fully assume all risks including, but not limited to, collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, sponsors, promoters, or drivers, and dangers arising from falls, road surface, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, weather conditions, as well as the possibility of physical and/or fixed or moving objects, the negligence of other riders, as well as the possibility of physical and/or mental trauma (or injury). I understand that the route requires bicycling on public roadways and in bad weather and that cyclists have been hospitalized and/or killed because of traffic mishaps that are either their responsibility or others' responsibility, and I further agree that I will bear all expenses incurred in any such accidents. I realize that TRIRI® requires physical conditioning, and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediment that would endanger myself or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during TRIRI® which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters, or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger either myself or others.

I hereby waive, release and discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives (including successors), TRIRI® the sponsors and promoters of TRIRI® including the Indiana Department of Natural Resources and each individual state property, J & B Event Management, Inc. and its employees, K & M Events, Hardy Lake SRA, the Bloomington Bicycle Club, Inc., or other sponsors or affiliated organizations and their respective agents, officers and employees (hereinafter referred to as the releasees) of and from any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me resulting from any and all negligence of the releasees for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly arising out of my participation in TRIRI® and leaving a vehicle parked in the space provided at Hardy Lake SRA. I agree that if I or anyone on my behalf makes a claim against any of the releasees, I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage or cost which may incur as the result of such a claim and any claims will be filed in Monroe County, Indiana.

I give my permission to TRIRI® to use my name and any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, articles, evaluations or any other record of my participation in the TRIRI® tour for any publicity and/or promotional purposes without obligation or liability to me.

I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle. I understand the Bloomington Bicycle Club/TRIRI® strongly suggest I wear a properly fitted, CPSC approved bicycle helmet on my head at all times while on my bicycle, and I will carry water and personal identification at all times and agree to abide by the rules of TRIRI®. The above agreements and representations are my express understandings of the risks, and I assume these voluntarily and freely without coercion or duress. This agreement may not be modified orally and may not be waived in any respect.
